110 Tower's LED exterior lighting system is part of the comprehensive \$15 million renovation program at 110 Tower, and presents many advantages over traditional light sources including lower energy consumption and operation cost, longer lifetime, improved robustness, smaller size and faster switching. The lighting system is made up of Philips/Color Kinetics iColor Accent Powercore LED lights with 20,080 programmable sections that can act in unison, or be individually programmed in 13 million color combinations. Operating from dusk to dawn, the lights are controlled by an astronomical clock that utilizes the Latitude and Longitude of 110 Tower to precisely calculate sunset and sunrise.

"110 Tower is an iconic figure in Downtown Fort Lauderdale and we wanted to do something special for the City of Fort Lauderdale and our surrounding neighbors," stated Laurel Oswald, senior vice president, Transwestern. "We are very excited to work with our community to pay tribute to the notable things they do throughout the year."

110 Tower was the first LEED Gold certified multi-tenant high-rise opportunity for commercial tenants in Downtown Fort Lauderdale. The building's Energy Star score placed it in the top 14% of similar buildings nationwide. 110 Tower's comprehensive renovation program also includes upgrades to the ground floor lobby, new ground floor retail, upgraded upper-floor common areas and other interior spaces, replacement and improvement of all building primary mechanical systems, and a unique exterior lighting system. New and existing amenities include New York Bagel Café & Deli, 110 Fitness, a bank, and conference center.
